Dear resident,




Stour Centre is back!

The new-look Stour Centre is now open after a £7.5m refurbishment. New features include an upgraded gym, soft play and clip and climb centre, an additional exercise studio, improved changing rooms and a revamped reception and café.

A digital plaque scheme celebrating the noteworthy individuals and buildings from many famous people have lived in the borough of Ashford. Authors, poets, mathematicians and philanthropists make up just some of the town's most famous residents and visitors.

The Heritage Plaque Scheme is similar to the national blue plaque scheme but features green plaques with the borough's crest. Plaques will be awarded to people or buildings who are not widely known or formally recognised in the borough.

Carbon neutral plan out to consultation

The plan supports the aim to achieve carbon neutrality within the council's own estate and operations by 2030 and emphasises the need for the whole community's involvement in achieving Ashford wide carbon neutrality before 2050.

Eight priority areas feature in the plan, focusing not just on

how the council can improve sustainability and achieve net zero carbon in our own operations, but also how we can encourage and enable all of Ashford to join us on this journey.
